GENERAL RULES

1. The college timing will be from 9.30 am to 5.30 pm
2. Ragging is strictly prohibited within/outside campus. Defaulters will be punished including expulsion from college.
3. Student must follow the time table strictly.
4. 80% attendance for theory and practical is mandatory, failing which he/she would be detained / disallowed for the sessional as well as University Examination.
5. In case of bonafide reason the college authorities should be informed well in advance for the leaves.
6. Students have to wear apron during practical hours.
7. For the lab work, the students must have with them the requirement specified by the faculty.
8. Discarding papers and similar material in the lab or corridor is strictly prohibited. The rules for disposal of waste papers and used chemicals are laid down which must be strictly followed.
9. Student shall be given home assignment by respective teachers which will be considered as an integral part of sessional practical examination.
10. Attendance for guest lectures will be compulsory.
11. Students will have to undergo one medical examination as per University procedure.
12. Students are neither allowed to sit on the steps, fence walls or loiter in the corridor and camps, nor sit in the canteen during college hours.
13. Loud talking near and around Principal's cabin, Library and Staff room shall be punishable.
14. Use of cell phones in the college premises is strictly prohibited.




